

# SafeLink Wireless

## What is SafeLink Wireless?

SafeLink Wireless service is a U.S. government supported program for income eligible households provided by TracFone Wireless, Inc. This service is limited to **one** person per household. Lifeline assistance is part of this program. It offers a free SafeLink Wireless cellular phone, free cellular service and free monthly minutes. There are no charges, contract or fees for those who qualify. The unused minutes will roll-over; if additional minutes are required, TracFone Airtime Cards must be purchased. Caller-ID, call waiting and voicemail features are included in the service. Exact benefits and eligibility requirements vary depending on the state. Upon approval you will receive service for one year after which you must re-qualify.

## SafeLink Wireless in Massachusetts

In Massachusetts qualified customers are eligible for a free cellular phone and 80 minutes per month. If you already receive LifeLine assistance on a landline or through another wireless provider you are not eligible for the SafeLink wireless program.

## Do you qualify?

You are eligible if you receive benefits from one of the following programs:

- Emergency Aid to the Elderly, Disabled and Children
- Social Security Income (SSI)
- Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program
- Food Stamps
- MassHealth
- Transitional Aid To Families with Dependent Children
- Fuel Assistance
